In the following years, he attended executive courses at St. Charles Business School of Management of Chicago, IESE Business School of Management, Wharton University of Pennsylvania, INSEAD University, SDA Bocconi and Harvard Business School.

Finance (Private Equity, Venture Capital & Real Assets) and Infrastructure are the main industries in which he has worked in Italy and abroad.

Since June 2023 he has been appointed CEO of Consip S.p.A. ( $\leq$  27,2 billion in annual value of contracts; ~1.7% Italy's GDP in 2023).



From 2019 to 2023 he served as Managing Director of InarCassa one of the most relevant Private Pension Funds (€ 14 billion in assets; €1.5 billion in revenues; 200,000 contributors).
